- Preparation of project applications and implementation of projects in the fields of energy efficiency, supply chain management, digitalisation, port logistics and management



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

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

- (3) **Equal treatment** of modes of transport



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








Monitoring activity: Water level situation - Danube



Action by PDI

To avoid situations like in 2021 and 2022, when it came to complete stand still on the Danube, we constantly monitor now the bottleneck @Belene islands.

2023, first remark placed in February lead to dredging in April/May.

Currently we increase pressure again, as we observed a missing depth deficit of about 40-50 cm, which will definitely lead to troubles during low water period.











Business relations involving the Danube



Examples:

- Turkey → Austria
- Upper Danube → Turkey
- RO-RO

Proposal:

- Use selected **Danube ports** as central hubs for Turkey-relations with making use of synergies and economies of scale
- Use the **Danube fairway** for green and efficient transport


